As a consequence of these issues, all SH students had last year's studies abruptly terminated. Many of them took advantage of this to gain practical experience in their own local clinics and communities. However soon they should be able to return to university as things normalise.

There will be no new intake of SH students this academic year as all the previous students have to repeat their year and there is no space on courses for a new entry.
